

CARRIE'S SCRAP QUILT

64 1/2" x 73 1/2"

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SUPPLIES NEEDED:

..Pattern-Carrie's Flannel Scrap Quilt by Starry Pines Pattern Co. (our friend Connie Huddleson who taught at the Oct. Getaway is the designer)

**You may purchase pattern from me for \$8 no shipping costs

..4 1/4 yards of scraps for piecing, applique and binding

**if you want your binding to be from one fabric (1/2 yard)

..2 3/4 yards of background fabric (this quilt also looks great with black background fabric)

..4 1/2 yards backing fabric

..2 yards of fusible web

..Black embroidery floss and a hand needle with an eye big enough for 2-3 strands of floss (if you want to do blanket stitch around letters by hand)

..Black machine quilting thread if you want to do the blanket stitch around your letters by machine

..Sewing machine with a blanket stitch button if you want to do blanket stitch by machine.

..Rotary board, 24" lucite ruler, rotary cutter

..Thread for piecing your quilt

..Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper, mechanical pencil, basic sewing supplies

..Ott Light or any desk light is very helpful to see in hotel classrooms

BEFORE GETAWAY:

We have a couple of options to make this quilt. #1 option: Make the quilt exactly like the pattern with rails for the center, triangles as one of the borders, and 2" squares for another border. #2 option: Make the quilt with rails for the center, **instead of using triangles for one of the borders-use 3 1/2" squares (much faster and would still look great)**, and 2" squares for another border. The choice is yours! This will help those of you who do not like to make triangles.

Connie has also supplied me with a full alphabet for the bubble letters that are used to spell out Home Sweet Home. **Another choice:** You can spell out whatever you want to have on your quilt. Happy Birthday Jeanette, Happy Anniversary, Cabin Sweet Cabin, Grandma Loves You, Kiss My Grits, the choice is yours AGAIN!!

Cut from your scraps BEFORE CLASS 120 – 2" X 9 1/2" rails, 62 – 3 1/2" sqs. for border with triangles or without triangles. *Personally I don't like to make my triangles out of squares. If you want to make triangles by cutting the squares into triangles before sewing you will need to cut 56 – 3 7/8" squares out of your scraps **NOT 3 1/2" squares**. Another choice, call me if you are confused. Bring ALL leftover scrap fabrics with you to class in case you cut something wrong.

If you have used fusible web before, you may trace your bubble letters to the fusible web leaving space between the letters to chunky cut out the individual letters. Yes, the letters should be backwards. Don't chunky cut out the letters before class, keep the web piece one piece. **If** you have time on your hands and you have used fusible web before...you may iron your web letters to the wrong side of your fabrics and cut the letters out, do not peel away the web.

DO NOT CUT OUT YOUR BACKGROUND FABRIC BEFORE CLASS. Please bring ALL YOUR FABRICS TO CLASS.
