

## FABRIC FRAMED MIRROR SUPPLY LIST

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Quilting isn't just for quilts! Here we've used quilting to make a lovely frame that could be used to enclose a mirror tile or to showcase a favorite photograph.

### **KIT INCLUDES:**

- ..One 12" Mirror Tile
- ..Poster Board
- ..Batting
- ..Tacky Glue
- ..Rings and ribbon to put on back of mirror to hang

### **SUPPLIES YOU NEED TO BRING:**

- ..Two 16" Squares and one 10" Square of fabric you want to use for your mirror
- ..Rotary cutter with old blade for cutting poster board, rotary board, and lucite ruler
- ..Sewing Machine capable of machine quilting
- ..Walking foot for straight line quilting on your fabric
- ..Darning foot if you want to free form quilt your fabric
- ..Thread to match your fabric for quilting
- ..Marking pencil that will show up on your fabric
- ..Fabric scissors, hand needle, basic sewing supplies

### **EMBELLISHMENTS – OPTIONAL: (bring embellishments with you)**

I used some pearl cotton to hand sew a blanket stitch around the middle of the little girls frame and made some little bows to glue around on top of the frame. You could also use buttons, lace, ribbons, beads, lots of choices. Wouldn't this make a cute baby shower gift? House warming gift? Then there's always Christmas...every every year.

You could use a pieced block that is left over from a quilt...as long as it is a 16" square. The back of the frame wouldn't need to be a pieced block, just something to coordinate.

I think it would be cool to make seasonal mirrors...spring, summer, fall, and winter looking fabrics.
