

## GEESE IN THE FIELDS QUILT 57" X 87"

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### SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- ..Pattern – Geese in the Fields by Far Flung Quilts (Pattern available from Easy As Pie Designs \$8 no shipping fee)
- ..Sewing Machine – one you are familiar with and bring book if possible
- ..Rotary Cutter, board, and ruler
- ..Basic sewing supplies (seam ripper, pins, extra sewing machine needles, etc.)
- ..Mechanical pencil works very well for drawing a line down the middle of your squares. If you have dark fabric you will need to bring a marking tool that you can see the line on your fabric squares.
- ..Thread to coordinate with your fabrics
- ..1/4" foot for machine helpful
- \*not needed if your needle moves from side to side on your sewing machine

### FABRIC NEEDED:

- ..13 Fat Quarters – these fabrics make up the "geese" and "fields" (Big 9 1/2" squares)
- ..2 1/2 yards background fabric
- \*I used 5 – 1/2 yards of different backgrounds to give it a scrappier look. I also used flannels for my quilt. I would strongly suggest you pre-wash flannels before cutting as they shrink differently depending a fabric company.

- ..5 yards Backing Fabric
- ..3/4 yards Binding Fabric

### BEFORE CLASS:

PLEASE cut out your quilt pieces at home where you have much more room. This will give you more time in class to do the fun part...sew and learn. Do bring your left over fabrics with you in case you had an "oops" in cutting. Follow "Cutting" chart and info on page 1 of your pattern. Please don't turn the page and start the next step, I have tips to share with you.
